The Fillmore District was once considered the Harlem of the West due to vibrant culture and influence in jazz music. However, in efforts to "clear slums" and "lower crimes," many Black and Brown communities were torn apart with promises for better lives. The Fillmore and Western Addition became one of the largest "urban renewal" experiments in the country. After decades of broken promises including divestment, abandonment, and gentrification, most Black San Franciscans have been pushed out entirely.
